Emergency First Aid with CPR Level C and AED (also known as First Aider I)

MHA Cost: \$83.50 1 day (8 hour course)

The primary focus is CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED (defibrillator), and emergency situations (ie. choking, bleeding, asthma, allergies). This course is aimed at individuals working within 30 minutes of a medical facility in low hazard work environments. This course is suitable for anyone who provides care for infants, children and/or adults, federal government employees, home care providers, coaches, spectators at any amateur sporting event, educational support staff, teachers, office or retail workers and parents.

Offered: Every day, 7 days a week in Winnipeg and weekly in Brandon

This course certifies you as a First Aider I in Manitoba for 3 years

Standard First Aid with CPR Level C and AED (also known as First Aider II)

MHA Cost \$126.00 2 day (16 hour course)

This class includes CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED, with more thorough coverage of First Aid situations (ie. environmental exposure, broken bones, splints). This course is aimed at individuals working more than 30 minutes from a medical facility or in higher hazard workplaces. This course is suited for industrial environments, law enforcement, fire fighters, first responders, life guards, construction, some health care workers.

Offered: 3 times a week including every weekend in Winnipeg and weekly in Brandon

This course certifies you as a First Aider II in Manitoba for 3 years

For groups of 10 or more, St. John would be happy to instruct a private course at your location.

Students who successfully complete St. John Ambulance certified training are covered by a blanket \$100,000 liability policy.
