Manitoba Hotel Association Launches Campaign To Promote Jobs In Hotel Industry *Hundreds Of Job Opportunities At Hotels In Urban And Rural Manitoba Available*

WINNIPEG, June 30, 2022 – The Manitoba Hotel Association (MHA) is launching a campaign to promote hundreds of jobs available at its member hotels throughout Manitoba. As the tourism industry recovers from the pandemic, the MHA is encouraging job seekers to apply to fill a variety of jobs currently available in Manitoba’s urban and rural hotels.

“The pandemic had a devastating impact on the hotel industry in Manitoba. We’re seeing strong signs that the industry is recovering, but many of our members still need to fill positions that were lost due to the pandemic,” says Scott Jocelyn, president and CEO of the Manitoba Hotel Association. “Promoting these jobs is our way of showing that the industry is bouncing back.”

Through its new “There’s Room For You” recruitment campaign, the MHA hopes to recruit energetic, passionate individuals. There are positions to fit just about any job seeker, including part-time opportunities and long-term professional careers.

“Some of the positions require special training, but many do not,” says Jocelyn. “Whether you’re a young adult, a student, a new Canadian or a person returning to the workforce, working in a hotel is a fantastic opportunity for you to learn and grow in your career.”

Funding for the campaign is provided by the Government of Canada and the Government of Manitoba.

“Our hospitality and tourism industries were hard hit by the pandemic, and we want to make sure they can seize every economic opportunity that the post-pandemic world will bring,” says Minister of Employment, Workforce Development and Disability Inclusion at the Government of Canada, Carla Qualtrough. “That’s why we’re investing in the Manitoba Hotel Association to ensure they have a strong, skilled workforce now, and into the future.”

Job seekers can submit their resume and contact information online through theresroomforyou.ca. They can also indicate which type of position they prefer to work in and which area of the province they would like to work. Positions range from roles in front desk, kitchen, housekeeping, bartending, banquet catering, management, maintenance and more.

Applicants may be contacted by one of the MHA’s member hotels.
